A highlight on The Ghan is gently cruising along Nitmiluk Gorge near Katherine, witnessing the awe-inspiring sandstone cliffs and visiting an Indigenous rock art site, where artwork persists in telling its story, even after thousands of years exposed to the elements. Travelling south on The Ghan, absorb the history of quirky Coober Pedy, an underground town built around opal mining, and enjoy an evening under a blanket of stars at the Alice Springs Telegraph Station, where Akubra's and dusty red boots meet white tablecloths and fine dining.

While crossing the continent on the Indian Pacific, there are two signature dining experiences on offer, depending on your direction of travel. Those heading west in the warmer months will pause in Rawlinna, a small outpost that borders the not-so-little Rawlinna Station, home to up to 80,000 sheep spread across 2.5 million acres, for an outback evening with a long-table dinner under the endless Nullarbor skies. Those travelling east stop in the Barossa Valley for an exclusive dining experience at Seppeltsfield Estate, showcasing the flavours and wines of the region.

Travelling toward Adelaide on the Great Southern summer adventure, dine beachside beneath fairy lights at Coffs Harbour. If you're headed towards Brisbane, get in touch with Mother Nature on a guided walk at the beautiful Venus Baths in the Grampians.

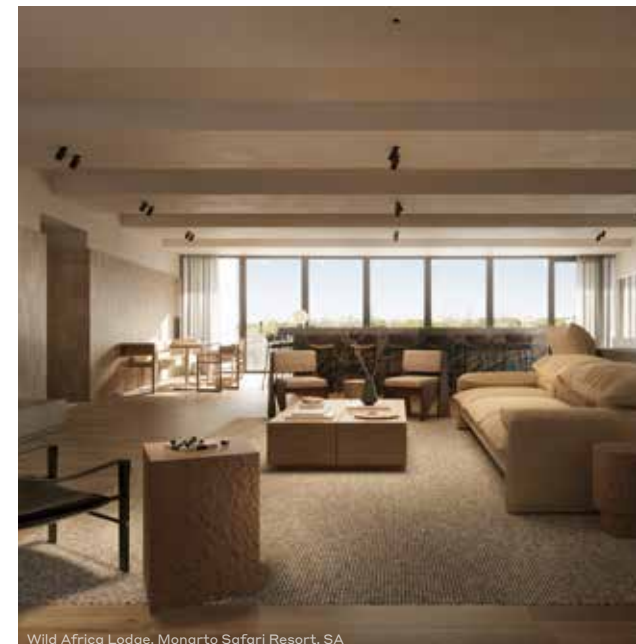

Day 3: Murwangi

Enjoy a BBQ lunch at Low Point, then a 4WD safari through Garig Gunak Barlu National Park, visiting the Nypa Palm gallery, Trepang Creek, savannah woodlands, and Gunners Quoin lookout before returning to the lodge for your final evening. (B, L, D)

Please note: Today, the tour will split into two groups to undertake the day's adventures. Group 1 will follow the itinerary above, while Group 2 will do the activities in reverse. Lunch arrangements are subject to change.

Day 12: Seven Spirit Bay to Darwin

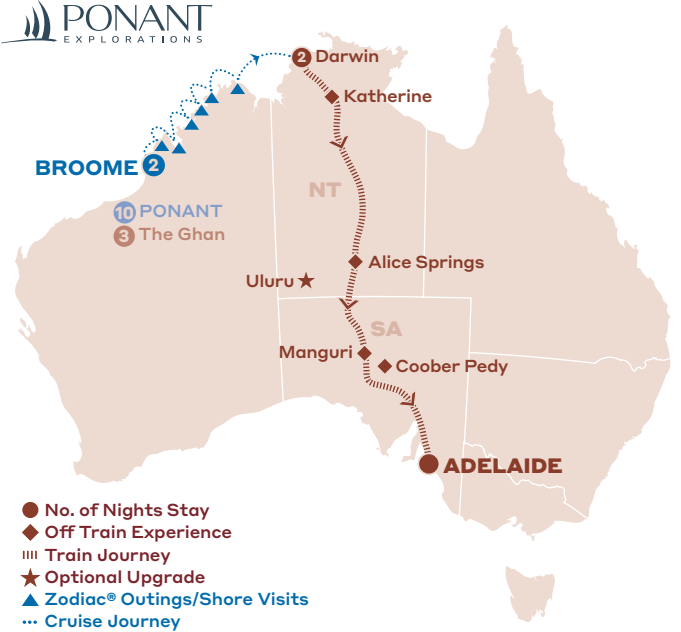

Day 5–6: Collier Bay, Horizontal Falls

The ancient landscapes of Collier Bay have been shaped by massive tidal movements, creating a photographer's paradise. With a tidal range exceeding 14 metres, this creates a unique phenomenon. Nestled in the centre of the bay is Montgomery Reef, the world's largest inshore reef system. As the tide falls, water cascades off the top of the reef, creating turbulent 'rivers' and mini waterfalls. Nestled at the southern end of Buccaneer Archipelago is Talbot Bay, home to the world's only Horizontal Falls. Also, hidden in the many caves and grottos of this ancient landscape are a multitude of ancient rock art galleries. (B,L,D)

Day 7: Careening Bay

Careening Bay was named by Lieutenant Phillip Parker King after his ship, the HMC Mermaid, was careened there in 1820. As the crew worked hard to re-float the vessel, the ship's carpenter carved the name of the vessel and the year into a boab tree. The boab tree is now three metres wide and National Heritage listed. (B,L,D)

Day 8: Hunter River

Arguably one of the most scenic parts of the Kimberley coast, Prince Frederick Harbour and the Hunter River are lined with pockets of ancient rainforest, pristine mangroves, and mosaic sandstone cliffs. The sandstone escarpment at the river mouth, known as "Kampamantiya", rises over 200 metres high before giving way to mud banks and mangrove forests. The Expedition Team will share their knowledge as you explore by Zodiac. You will also have the opportunity to reach the Mitchell Falls by helicopter (additional cost) from Naturalist Island Beach. (B,L,D)

Day 9: Swift Bay

The Bonaparte Archipelago consists of a rugged maze of islands stretching almost 150 kilometres along the coast. The bay is composed of fractured sandstone, providing an abundance of rock shelters. On the walls of these shelters are examples of Wandjina and Gwion Gwion style rock art. Join your Expedition Team for a guided walk to these rock art galleries. (B,L,D)

Day 10: Vansittart Bay

Jar Island contains ancient rock art galleries depicting the Gwion Gwion style unique to the Kimberley region. Gwion Gwion art may extend to over 30,000 years before our time and represents the first wave of seagoing colonisers of the Australian continent. These are the oldest detailed depictions of human figures in the world. Join your Expedition Team ashore for a walk to the site of the Gwion Gwion art galleries. (B,L,D)

Day 11: King George River

The journey up the King George River is breathtaking. The 80-metre-high sides of the gorge display varying degrees of weathering of the Warton sandstone, with the colours and textures changing with the light. The King George twin falls are the highest single-drop falls in the Kimberley. Your Expedition Team will escort you to the foot of the falls and explain the geological formations of the canyon. (B,L,D)

Day 12: Le Soleal or Le Jacques Cartier at sea

Enjoy a day at sea and take advantage of the on-board facilities. Your Expedition Team will provide an enrichment programme, focusing on Australian history, flora, and fauna. Lovers of the open sea can visit the ship's upper deck and perhaps be lucky enough to spot marine species. (B,L,D)

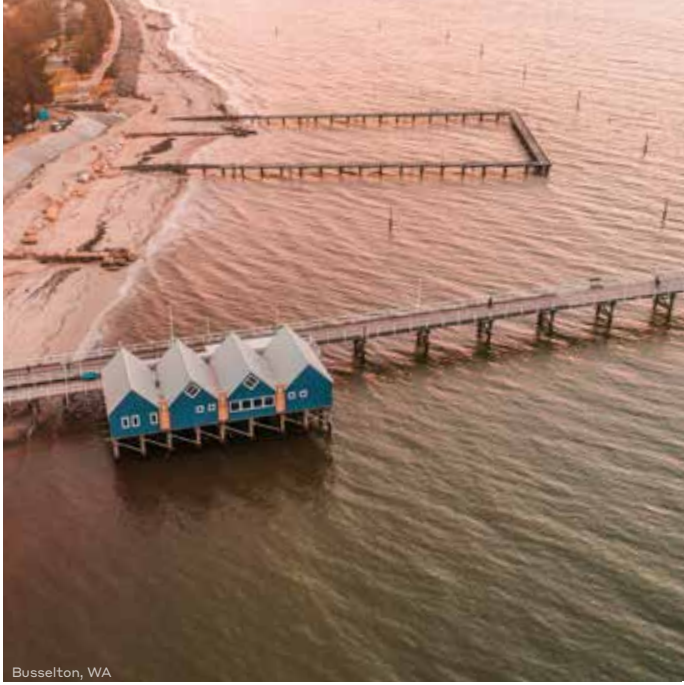

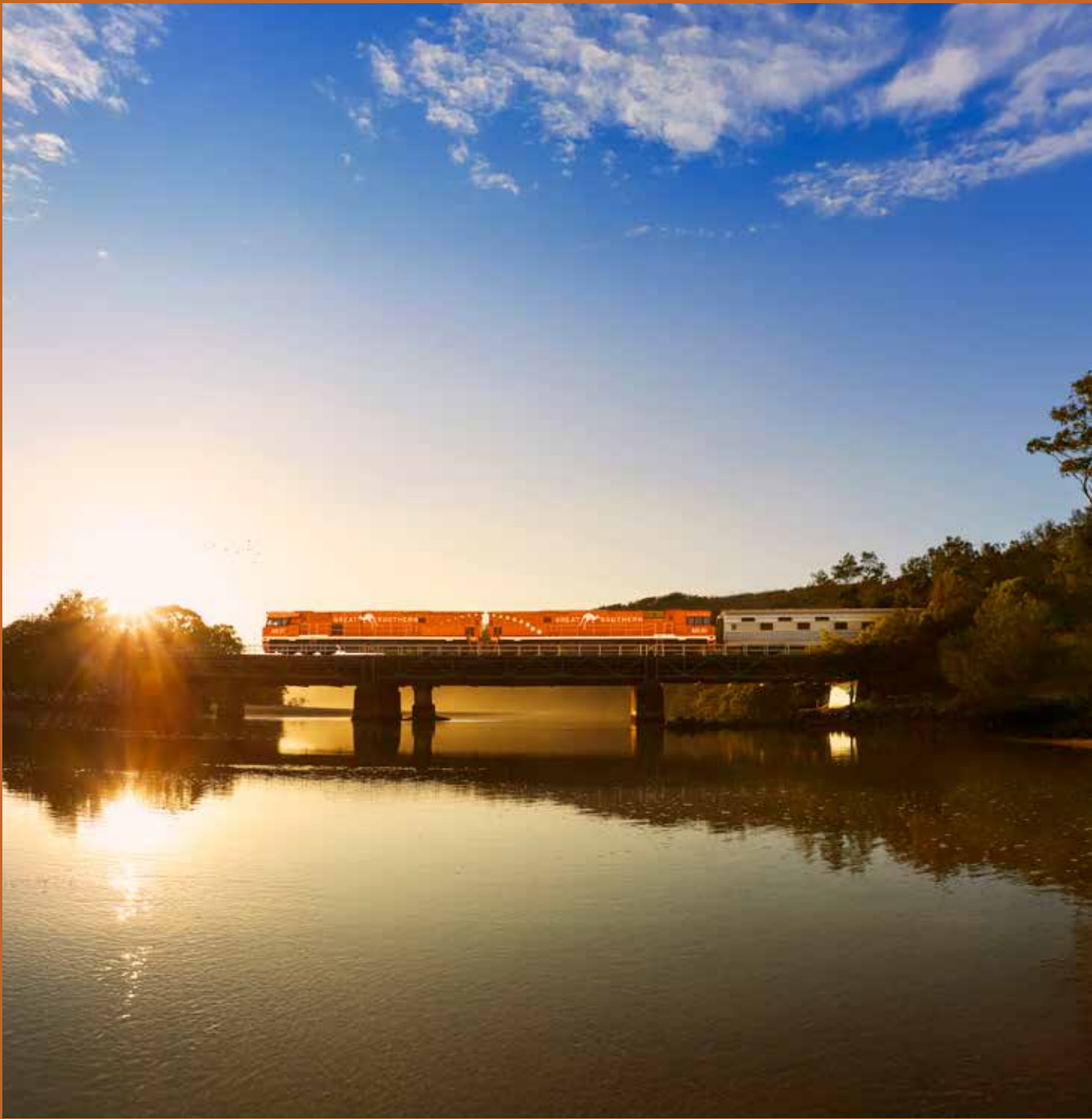

Arriving on 'KI' reveals a haven of protected reserves, striking landscapes and abundant wildlife. An eco-adventure cruise introduces the island's rich biodiversity before we settle into Kingscote, our base for three nights as we explore this remarkable nature-lover's paradise. (B,L,D)

Day 6: Kangaroo Island

A full day of exploring is ahead of us as we visit some of the island's famous and lesser-known sights. First stop is Seal Bay Conservation Park which is home to Australia's largest colony of breeding sea lions. 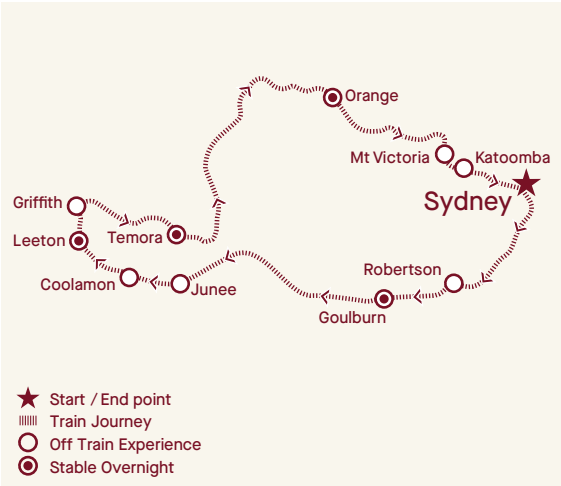

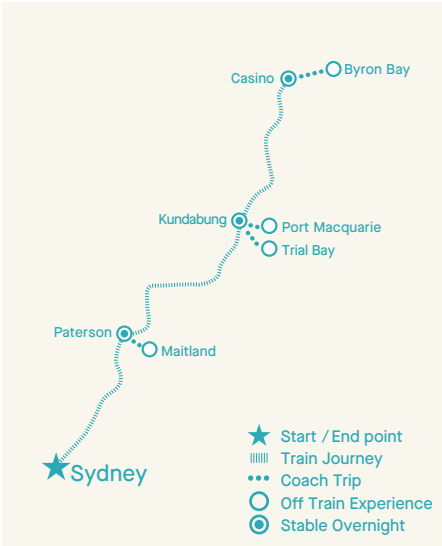

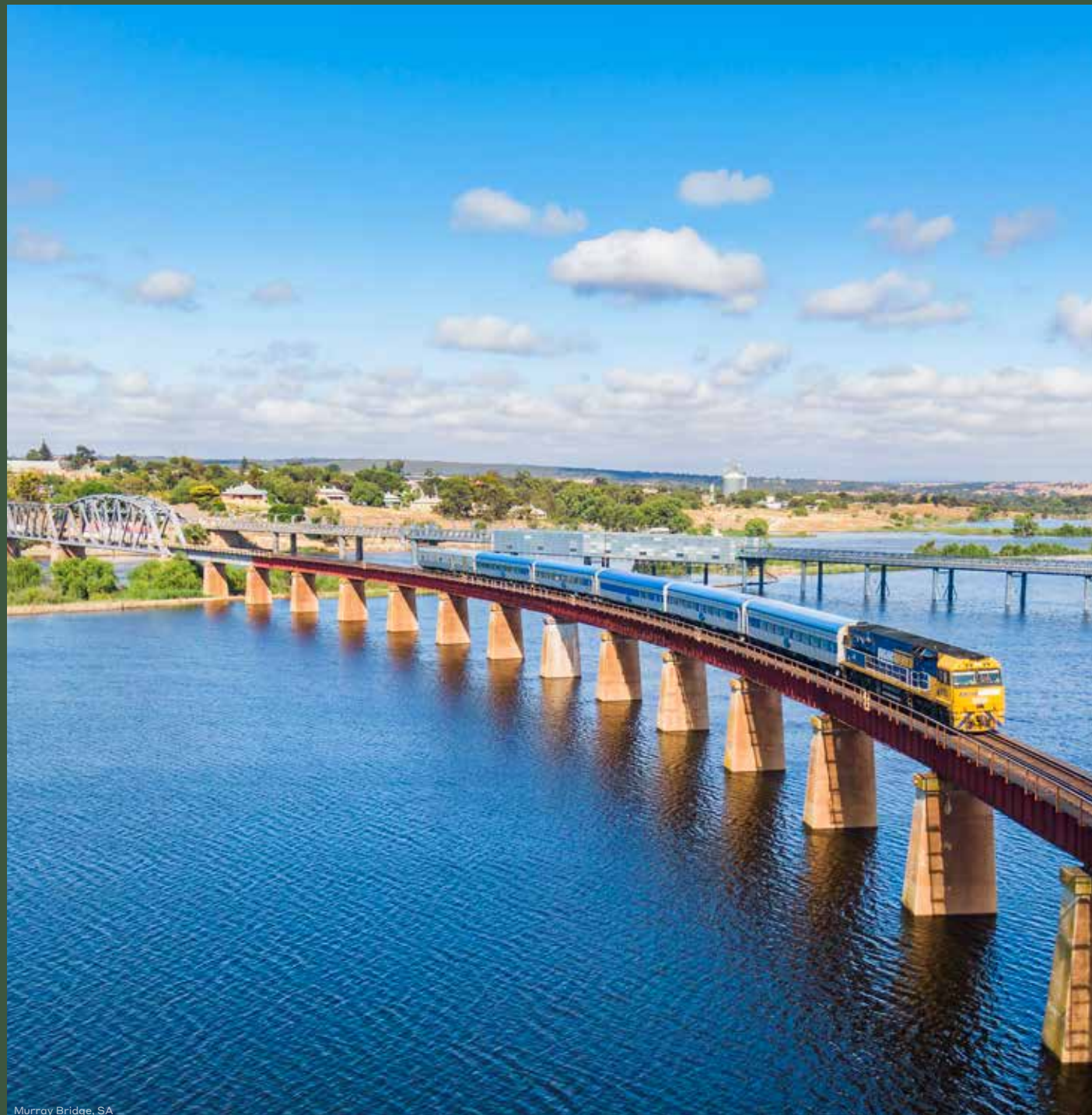

ALICE SPRINGS *Telegraph Station*

A walk through history



Telegraph Station, Alice Springs, NT

The Alice Springs Telegraph Station Historical Reserve marks the original site of the first European settlement in Alice Springs.

The station was established in 1871 to relay messages between Darwin and Adelaide along the Overland Telegraph Line, which connected Australia's population centres with the north of the country and Britain using the undersea telegraph network. Before the line was built, a message to England would have to travel by boat, taking 3-4 months each way. After the telegraph line was built, morse code messages could reach London in as little as 5 hours – slow by today's standards, but revolutionary for people of the 19th century.

The Historic Museum

Join a guided tour through the heritage museum and precinct to immerse yourself in the history of the Telegraph Station, the origins of Alice Springs as a town and the Stolen Generation of the Bungalow era of the 1930s. Travel back in time, and explore the inner workings of the original Telegraph Station and Post Office, as well as experience a working display of Meidinger batteries – replicas of those that powered the Overland Telegraph Line back in the 1870s – unique to the southern hemisphere.

The Trail Station Café is nestled along the vibrant Alice Springs Trail, next to the historic Alice Springs Telegraph Station.
